## [ HISTORY OF THE MUSEUM ]

- 1896** Millennial Exhibition in Budapest City Park with romantic-eclectic style pavilion dedicated hungarian technical and engineering innovation
- 1899** Permanent exhibition is opened in the pavilion as the new Museum of Transport (one of the first transport museum worldwide)
- 1944** The museum is hit by bombs during World War 2, severe damages to both building and collection
- 1966** The Museum is rebuilt in a modest way and reopened, became a centre for transport history research
- 1987** Extension of exhibition spaces
- 2009** Integration of Hungarian Transport and Technical Museums
- 2016** Demolition of the old City Park Building (parallel with park reconstruction)



## [ HISTORY OF THE INVESTMENT ]

- ◆ The City Park building was not suitable for accommodating the ever-expanding collection and archives, even underground extensions.
- ◆ The Museum searched for a new location in Budapest brownfield zone with authentic industrial heritage and good transport connections.
- ◆ The Government accepted the Museum's proposal about the new location in the area of the former MÁV Northern Maintenance Depot and also made available the resources for the preparation process (design contest and planning)
- ◆ [ Government Resolution 2011/2017 (XII.22.) ]
- ◆ The Museum made a master plan covering the whole area for preparing the upcoming design contest.



## [ THE COLLECTION AND ITS PLACEMENT ]

- ◆ More than 21,000 transport-related items from the last two hundred years.
- ◆ archive and library of 200,000 volumes of books, journals, plans and other written material
- ◆ 3,000 items will be on display in the new permanent exhibition, the rest will be placed in visitable storages
- ◆ focus on land transportation (shipping and aviation history will be located elsewhere)
- ◆ 30% more artifacts is expected to be purchased and stored in the next 30 years
- ◆ approximately 620 vehicles to be placed in the new museum complex (100 railway vehicles, 60 buses and trucks, 150 cars)





## [ CONCEPT OF EXHIBITION ]

Expected duration of a single visit is 3.5 to 4 hours on site


**Storyline:** the history of Hungarian transportation based on social chronology




